The Islamic Association of Shenandoah Valley (IASV) opened its doors to the public for daily congregational prayers on June 6th, 2020 . Alhumdillah, through the grace and mercy of Allah SWT, we were able to keep our doors open providing daily congregational prayers and later, weekly Jummah.

Alhamdulillah, your patience and support has given us the confidence to hold the Eid ul Adha Prayers at our Social Hall and Parking Lot facility, In Shaa Allah on Friday, July 31.

In Sha Allah, to this effect, **IASV will be hosting Two Eid prayers, 7:00 AM, and 9:00 AM.** It is imperative that all individuals wear masks once they exit their vehicle and utilize a prayer mat. This is very important to ensure the safety of our congregants and prevent outbreaks.

Our capacity within the IASV Social Hall (62 spots) and Parking Lot (68 Spots) is approx 130 spots all together per prayer. So, it will be **first-come first-serve**. Once all of the spots are filled, no further entry will be allowed.

If you pray outside in Parking Lot, please look for arrow sign for Qibla Direction and tune your radio at FM 97.9 to listen the Imam voice for Khutabah and Prayers.

The following rules are effective for attending Eid Salat:

- Masks must be worn at all times. No Mask, No Entry.
- Please bring your own prayer rug or sheet.
- If you are feeling sick - stay home and help protect our congregation.
- Children under the age of 15 are recommended to stay home.
- Practice 6 feet of social distancing at all times and avoid embracing and Hand Shaking.
- Please perform wudu at home as the restrooms will be closed.

We pray that Allah SWT continues to protect our community from the COVID-19 pandemic and allows our doors to always remain open to our faithful congregants.
